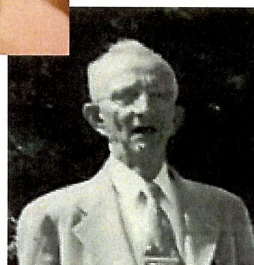
IT ALL STARTED WITH ANNA & JOHN
